





President

### President

Will preside over all regular meetings, ride leader and officer meetings of the LHC. The President will appoint all committees and shall act as an ex officio member thereof, with the exception of the elections nominating committee.

# President Responsibilities

- 1. Provide the SCLH Activities Department with a revised and signed "SCLHHOA Group Contacts Update Form" with no less than three (3) contacts including phone numbers and email addresses and officer election results, if any changes.
- 2. Monitor the LHC budget and finances.
- 3. Manage the Rides with GPS (RwGPS) contract with the LHC.
- 4. Solicit volunteer LHC members to submit monthly articles to the SCLH Compass, Lincoln News Messenger and Sun City Senior News, supervise the news media writers.
- 1. Appoint one LHC member as Safety Coordinator.
- 2. Appoint one LHC member as the LHC Website Webmaster.

### Vice President

- Will work in cooperation with the President and shall, in absence or disability of the President, perform the duties and exercise the powers of the President.
- The Vice President may be delegated by the President to perform one or more duties of the President.
- In the event of the resignation of the President during their term of office, the Vice President shall therefore become President.

# Vice President Responsibilities:

- 1. Maintain and keep up to date the Ride Leader Roster on the LHC Website.
- 2. Establish and coordinate the training of Ride Leaders in the use of the Ride with GPS System.
- 3. Schedule Ride Leader and Safety Meeting meetings as required.
- 4. Assist the Webmaster with coordination and maintenance of the rides and Ride Schedules.
- 5. Coordinate and manage the request for bids on all activities involving contractors for events and products for the LHC.
- 6. Review the LHC Website.

# Secretary/Treasurer

The LHC Secretary/Treasurer will work with the other Officers and maintain proper fiscal controls over the resources and assets of the LHC.

# Secretary/Treasurer Responsibilities

- 1. Maintain the LHC bank account with a signature card bearing the signatures of the President and Secretary/Treasurer.
- 2. Promptly record all receipts and deposit funds in the Wells Fargo checking account.
- 3. Oversee all non-profit tax information required by the Internal Revenue Service
- 4. Collect dues and all other monies while maintaining a current and accurate accounting of the LHC finances.
- 5. Oversee the Community Affairs program as needed for funding requests.
- 6. Ensure communications to membership is maintained via emails regarding LHC business.
- 7. Maintain an up-to-date dues roster.
- 8. Maintain an up-to-date roster with the LHC Webmaster. Inform members of the roster password.
- 9. Make all payments for authorized LHC bills.
- 10. Report the financial status of the LHC at the Ride Leader Meetings and LHC General Member Meetings.
- 11. Maintain a current file of all member applications.
- 12. Record and preserve the minutes of all meetings.

### CA Bikeway Electric Bike (ebike) Information

Electric Bikes are Identified in CA by label w/ Type, Max Assisted Speed, Motor Wattage

- Type 1 Pedal assist, max speed 20 mph
- ❖ Type 2 Throttle (handle bar) control, max speed 20 mph
- Type 3\* Pedal assist, max speed 28 mph

#### CA Bike Lane Classifications

- Bike Lane: Established along streets adjacent to motor vehicles with single solid white line.
- Buffered Bike Lane: Uses chevrons or diagonal markings to separate vehicle traffic from on-street parking.
- Bike Route: Uses bike route signage and/or shared road markings to designate a preferred route for cyclists.
- **Bicycle Boulevard:** Prioritizes bicycle travel on streets shared with vehicle traffic.
- Separated Bikeways: For cyclists exclusively and are physically separated from motor traffic, with flex posts, inflexible barriers, grade separation, and/or parked cars.
- Shared Roadway Bicycle Markings (Sharrows): Alert traffic that bicycles can occupy the lane for safe lane position. Did you know, "sharrows" is a combination of two words, shared and arrows.

### Be Aware:

- > Team: "Lincoln Hills Cyclists" is plural.
- Register: 3"R's" = Register, Ride, Record
- Record: Be aware of the way the system software is set up each year. The program focuses on "trips." If you register 25 miles it will sometimes convert that to 50 miles. E.g., 25 miles point "A" to "B" and a return of 25 miles point "B" to "A." Double check your total mileage history.
